



COLLABORATIVE ACTIVITY

SCAVENGER HUNT

DURATION: approx. 30 – 60 mins

PURPOSE:

This activity encourages people to reflect on what being collaborative means to them personally and to share thoughts across the team. The activity itself also includes team work.

PREPARATION:

- This activity can either be done by asking people in advance to bring 1 item that represents 'collaborative' to them to the session (option 1).
- Or you could get people/groups to find the item on the day (option 2).

STEPS:

Option 1 (30 mins depending on team size)

- Ask everyone to bring 1 item to the session that represents collaborative/collaboration to them. This can be anything!
- People present how their item represents collaborative /collaboration

Option 2 (approx. 60 mins)

- Split people into groups of 4-5 people
- Give the groups 20-30 mins to go out across the campus and find 1 item that represents 'collaborative'. Everyone in their individual group must agree with the choice of item.
- The groups reconvene and explain how their item represents 'collaborative' for their group
- Discuss themes and any different approaches

Option 3 (approx. 60 mins)

- Split people into 5 groups or pairs depending on the size of the team
- Give each group one Value and 20-30 mins to go out across the campus and find 1 item that represents that value. Everyone in their individual group must agree with the choice of item.
- The groups reconvene and explain how their item represents their specific value
